## SERVICES / RESOURCES

The Harbor provides a safe place to connect youth and their families to services they may need. Our goal is to prevent youth from entering the local juvenile justice system by helping families cope with problem behavior before issues potentially escalate into more serious trouble. Services are free and tailored to the unique needs of each youth.

Resources include referrals to court diversion programs, tutoring, educational support, mentoring, substance abuse interventions, conflict management, job development, counseling, cognitive behavioral therapy and other programs.

## MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AND SUPPORT

Youth who are referred to the Harbor are evaluated to identify any mental health and/or therapeutic needs, as well as any concerning behaviors or situations that warrant interventions. Staff members are trained to identify strengths and assets of each youth, and to help families cope with any underlying issues that may be occurring in their households.

### Signs a youth may need help include:



- Drug or alcohol use
- Isolation
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Bullying or fighting
- Changes in behavior

Services are family-centered, taking into account each family's unique needs and wishes concerning treatment and referrals.
